## A NOTE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

This past year, our amazing team at Sandusky County Family & Children First has demonstrated dedication and true commitment as they rose to the challenges presented through implementation of OhioRISE. We have successfully learned to navigate the statewide changes made to Wraparound Service Coordination and our local system of care, and have successfully managed the integration of data into the new statewide family collection database, OASCIS. I would like to take this opportunity to recognize the quality work and the loyalty of my staff, as well as my Executive Team, Council Members, and community partners who serve the children and families of Sandusky County. This next year FCFC will focus efforts upstream, and provide more outreach and education opportunities to ensure families know about our services as early as possible. In the past, families have shared that they wish they knew about FCFC's Wraparound services earlier. This past year Sandusky County Family & Children First received 57 new referrals, with most of these youth being age 13 or older. We know there is room for continuous improvement and as such, we will continue to strengthen partnerships, build upon existing programs and enhance our presence in the community.

## ECCC: Transition from Early Intervention to LEA

ECCC is a local collaboration between FCFC, the Board of DD and area school districts to ensure a safe and planful transition from 0-3 Part C Early Intervention Services to Part B Education Services.

## Early Intervention Service Coordination

An Early Intervention (EI) team screens and evaluates children to determine eligibility for services. A child may be eligible if they have a medical diagnosis, a developmental delay or disability, or a developmental concern.

# Wraparound Service Coordination

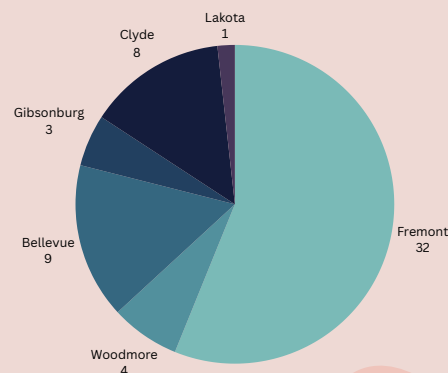
Wraparound Service Coordination is a function of that Council which provides coordinated access to services for families with needs in multiple systems and builds on the strengths of the social services already provided.

## SCHOOL DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE



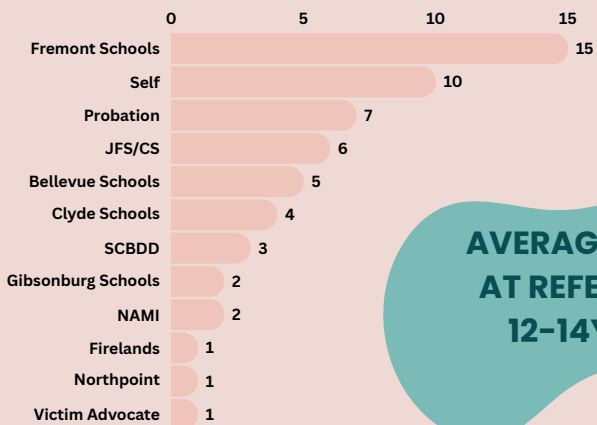

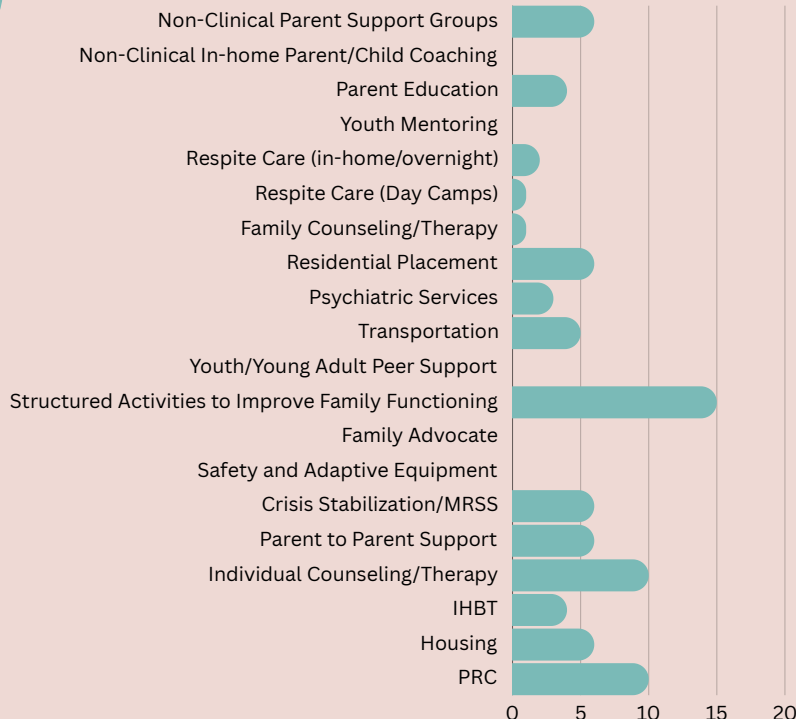

## REFERRAL SOURCE

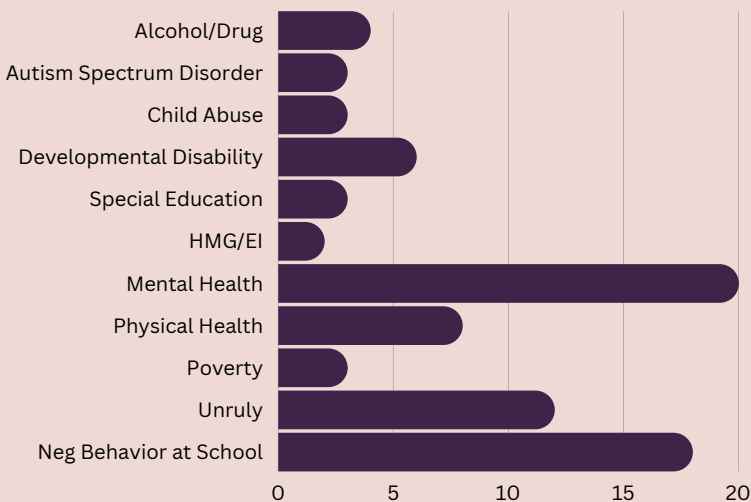


**AVERAGE AGE AT REFERRAL**
